

How to Paragraph

A how- to -paragraph is a form of expository writing. We are going to make this very simple. You will need a topic sentence, three supporting statements and a concluding sentence for a total of five sentences. You may add more supporting sentences, but you must have at least five sentences. Your subject will be how to make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich. In a how- to- paragraph you must use transition words at the beginning of some of your sentences such as: next, then, first, second, third, in addition, as a result., the next step, afterward.....

It is a given that you are in your kitchen ready with a knife, bread and peanut butter and jelly. Start here.

Topic Sentence(This should be the main idea of your paragraph. What is your paragraph going to teach the reader? In this instance your subject is how to make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich)
